Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to take action on the representation moved by the petitioner.

The petitioner alleges that on 25.03.2022, the respondents No. 5 to 7 entered the house of the petitioner. They misbehaved with her. They beat her brother-in-law namely, Harjinder Singh, who came to aid her and took away Rs. 1 lac from her brother-in-law Harjinder Singh. Petitioner and her brother-in-law suffered injuries. They were medically examined. The copies of MLR's have been annexed as Annexure P-1 and

P-2. In this regard petitioner has submitted a representation (P-4) addressed amongst the respondents to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, however, no action thereon has been taken.

Notice of motion.

Mr. B.S. Sewak, Addl. A.G., Punja has accepted notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or opining on the veracity of the allegations contained in the representation, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as raised by her in the application (P-4) and take appropriate action, in accordance with law.
