Complaining non-compliance of the order dated 01.09.2021,
the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 11 and 12 of
the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads
as under:-

“In view of the above , the present
petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent
No.2 to decide the legal notice issued by the
petitioner dated 30.11.2020 (Annexure P-17) and
take a conscious decision thereon by passing a
speaking order, within a period of three months from
the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner
is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such
a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits
shall also be released to the petitioner within a further
period of three months ; from the date of such
conscious decision of the authorities.”

Learned counsel representing the respondent submits that
speaking order will be passed positively, within a period of 15 days,
from today.

In view of the aforesaid, no further order is required to be
passed.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also
disposed of.
