This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to consider the candidature of the petitioner for the post of Male Constable (General Duty), Police Department, Haryana vide advertisement No.4/2020, Category No.1. In this regard, a representation dated 16.03.2022 (Annexure P-5) has been given by the petitioner to respondent, but till date no decision has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that the respondent will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner. Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to decide the representation dated 16.03.2022 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
