Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in FIR No.46 dated 20.3.2021 registered under Sections, 307, 379-B, 341, 506, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

On 20.5.2021 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* submits that no injury is attributed to the petitioners. There is also a delay of five days in registration of the FIR.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Manpreet Singh Nagra, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and waives service.

In the meantime, the petitioners are directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 28.05.2021 at 10:00 a.m. and cooperate therewith. In the event of their arrest, they shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to their compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 27.09.2021.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioners have joined the investigation; have cooperated with the investigating agency and that their custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the order of this Court dated 20.5.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
