The present is a first petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.133 dated 17.05.2021 (Annexure P-1), under Section 15/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sirsa, District Sirsa.
