Counsel for the petitioner, while restricting his arguments, submits that only grievance of the petitioner is that petitioner No.1 applied for grant of police clearance certificate (PCC) in January, 2022 with office of respondent No.2 as he intends to go abroad. However, the police authorities failed to take any action and the matter is still pending before respondent No.2. He further contends that direction be given to respondent No.2 to consider and decide his request for issuance of PCC.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide request, if any, made by petitioner No.1 for grant of PCC to him in accordance with law within next one month of the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
