Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was granted benefit of military service by the respondent-department vide order dated 10.01.2019 (Annexure P/5) but, no consequential benefit has been given to the petitioner despite the fact that the seniority of the petitioner was fixed at Sr.No.250-A. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the petitioner had approached the respondents several times to grant him consequential benefits but, to no avail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 10.01.2019 (Annexure P/5), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction be issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 10.01.2019 (Annexure P/5), in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 10.01.2019 (Annexure P/5) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
