Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.35 dated 30.04.2021, under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC, registered at Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot, Punjab.

This Court vide order dated 21th May, 2021 had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to the compliance of conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and since then, the case is being adjourned. It is apparent from the record that on 28th January, 2022 and thereafter, on 3rd March, 2022, neither the petitioner nor his counsel appeared. No one is present for the petitioner even today. The State was directed to file status report and the same has been filed.

Learned State counsel has drawn the attention of the Court to the status report filed wherein, it is mentioned that the petitioner had departed on 20th August, 2021 to Sweden on Student Visa from Bangalore Airport vide Flight No.LH-755 and has not returned till date.

Needless to say that the petitioner was granted interim bail on 21th May, 2021 subject to the compliance of conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. wherein it was mandatory for the petitioner to seek the permission of the Court before leaving the country. There is nothing on record to show that the petitioner had left India with the permission of the Court.

In view of the above, this court finds that petitioner has violated the terms and conditions of the interim bail granted to him. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
