This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail for a period of fifteen days to the petitioner (from 01.05.2022 to 15.05.2022) in case FIR No.615 dated 04.10.2021 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 307 and 379-B IPC, 1860 at Police Station Krishna Gate Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, as his marriage is scheduled for 06.05.2022.

Learned counsel for petitioner contends that the marriage of the petitioner is to be solemnized on 06.05.2022 and has invited the attention of the Court to the marriage card (Annexure P-3). He prays that the petitioner be released on interim bail for a period of fifteen days.

Notice of the application to respondent-State.

At this stage, Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and states that indeed the marriage of the petitioner is scheduled for 06.05.2022.

After considering the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the stand of learned State counsel, this Court is not inclined

to grant interim regular bail to the petitioner, however, it is directed that the Superintendent District Jail, Kurukshetra, after verification shall facilitate the visit of petitioner to the venue to attend his own marriage ceremony and after completion of ceremony, he be brought back to the prison. It is made clear that all the expenses for travel, etc. shall be borne by petitioner.
