Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner-prosecutrix seeks issuance of directions for early disposal of Criminal case bearing No.SC-ST-10 of 2019 *State vs Sheikh Sadiq* which is pending before the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram.

Learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, submits that after investigation of the FIR got registered by the petitioner, on 16.06.2019, the State had filed a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. on the basis whereof on 01.11.2019 the Trial Court framed charges against the accused; thereafter, all the material witnesses cited by the prosecution have been examined and that only six official witnesses remain to be produced.

The accused are being tried for rape; such trial is pending for the last about 2 ½ years; all material witnesses in the same have since been examined and only six official witnesses remain to be produced.

After considering the afore undisputed facts, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to dispose of the trial in question within four months from the date next fixed before it, in accordance with law.
