Through this writ petition, the petitioners call in question the correctness of notices dated 25.10.2017 & 19.01.2018, orders dated 12.02.2018 and 14.12.2018.

In substance, the petitioner's flour mill has been ordered to be sealed by the Municipal Corporation, Sonapat. The building continues to be under seal of the Municipal Corporation, Sonapat, for the last four years. An order of sealing a building is interlocutory in nature. The Municipal Corporation cannot sit over the file indefinitely.

The statute requires the Municipal Corporation to take the proceeding to its logical end. Sh. Rajesh Sheoran, the learned counsel

representing the Municipal Corporation, Sonapat, expresses his inability to disclose the status of the further proceedings.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Municipal Corporation, Sonapat, to pass final order positively within a period of one month after granting opportunity of hearing to the concerned.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
