AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed in the nature of Habeas Corpus to release the detenue-Naseema who was allegedly illegally detained at the residential premises of respondents No. 4 to 10.

Notice of motion was issued to official respondents.

Reply dated 9.5.2022 is filed by learned State Counsel, the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite.

As per the reply filed, FIR No. 62 dated 4.3.2022 was registered under Sections 363, 366 IPC at P.S. Buria at the instance of Sabila W/o Babar. The allegations were that her daughter was missing and she had an apprehension that Hitesh Kumar alias Hanitesh Kumar S/o Anoop had eloped her daughter on the pretext of marriage. The official respondents searched the residential premises of the private respondents, neither Hitesh Kumar alias Hanitesh Kumar nor Naseema were found. It is

pleaded that the FIR is being investigated and as soon as the girl is found, she will be produced before the Illaqa Magistrate.

At this stage no case is made out for illegal detention, no further directions are called for.

Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedies in accordance with law including pursuing the FIR No. 62 dated 4.3.2022.
