This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.33 dated 1.2.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Kasola, District Rewari (Haryana).

A complaint was filed by Senior Manger of Accil Auto Steels Pvt. Bawal Ltd. alleging that Vinod Kumar (petitioner) working as Assistant Manager (Account Department) had forged quotation vouchers, purchase order and issued fake bills thereby misappropriated Rs. 24 lakhs of the company.

The petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 22.7.2020.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Rajesh Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined investigation, given his specimen signatures. She further submits that e-mail ID and its password has to be provided by the petitioner.

Mr. Nikhil Kumar, Advocate, appears for complainant and opposes the bail and submits that loss of Rs.24 lakhs was suffered by the company due to conduct of petitioner.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner would continue to join investigation as and when called for, he has given and will again give e-mail ID and password.

In view of above, interim bail granted is made absolute.

However, in case of non-cooperation by the petitioner, the State would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
