The petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to grant him extension of parole for a period of three months as he is undergoing treatment of his right foot as the same has been amputated on 16.04.2022.

Learned counsel for the State has filed reply by way of short affidavit dated 23.05.2022 of the Superintendent, District Jail Sangrur on behalf of respondent No. 3 which is taken on record. As per the medical certificate dated 16.05.2022 issued by Amandeep Hospital, Amritsar (Annexure R-IV), the petitioner was admitted in the hospital on 16.04.2022 with diagnosis of right diabetic foot with DM & PVD. He underwent debridement with right partial foot amputation on 16.04.2022 and debridement + VAC on 22.04.2022. He was discharged on 23.04.2022 and approximately six weeks' time would be required for wound healing including dressing surgery and post-operative wound healing.

Keeping in view of above medical certificate (Annexure R-IV), petition is allowed and extension of parole is being granted to the petitioner till six weeks from 16.05.2022 subject to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. He will surrender before the Jail Authority, Sangrur on 28.06.2022 after availing benefit of parole.
