[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 15.11.2021, in CWP No.23053 of 2021 in case titled as Ranjit Singh vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.23053 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent herein to take a decision on representation dated 24.08.2021 in accordance with law expeditiously and in any case within three months from the receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of speaking order dated 12.12.2022 holding the petitioner entitled to grant of ACP as well as special increment but not for the special allowance. The aforementioned order is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned

counsel for the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that in the

circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 12.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
