Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present case, the seniority of the petitioners was amended and as per the said amended seniority, their service should have been fixed vis-a-vis their junior and they be promoted with effect from the date their junior was promoted, with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance of the petitioners which has been made in the present petition, has already been raised before the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 10.02.2022 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deepali Puri Sandhu, Additional Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 10.02.2022 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 10.02.2022 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 10.02.2022 (Annexure P-7) within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
