1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 16.03.2021, in CWP-38238-2018, in case titled as Nitesh Sharma vs. State of Haryana and another.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1, reveals that CWP-38238-2018, was allowed and the respondents were directed to pay the requisite minimum pay scale to the petitioner from the date of joining within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in this case.

4. However, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced order dated 09.05.2022, releasing payment of Rs.10,73,100/- in terms of the decision in CWP-38238-2018, as modified vide order dated 15.03.2022, in LPA-674-2021, subject to the outcome of the SLP pending before Hon'ble the Supreme Court.

5. The aforementioned order is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

6. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
