AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The petitioner is before this Court seeking regular bail in FIR No. 14, dated 14th July, 2018, under Section 302 IPC, registered at Police Station Nakodar City, District Jalandhar.
2. One of the main ground for seeking bail is the custody period. Coupled with the fact that the trial is not moving at a decent pace.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that material witnesses were examined and only official witnesses are remaining.
4. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that official witnesses will be examined within three months from the next date fixed.
5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further orders is required to be passed at this stage.
6. The petition is disposed of.

accommodating the dates for expeditious deposition of the prosecution evidence, there is no doubt, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
