NATIONAL SEEDS CORPORATION V/S KISHORE KUMAR & ANR.

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Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

It is conceded position that respondent No.1, who was owner & driver of the truck, has since died. Appellant took time to bring on record the legal representatives of the deceased respondent but it has not been able to locate the address or otherwise find out as to who are the legal representatives of the deceased-respondent No.1. In the circumstances, it is stated by the representative of the appellant-Corporation that the record of the appeal be consigned to record but liberty be granted to the appellant to get it revived after moving an appropriate application along with an application for bringing on record the legal representatives as & when it is able to trace out the legal representatives.

In view of the above, the record of this appeal is ordered to be consigned to record, but liberty is granted to the appellant to get the appeal revived after moving an appropriate application along with an application for bringing on record the legal representatives of the deceased-respondent No.1.
