Case heard via video conference.

By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.57, dated 11.02.2021, registered at Police Station Thanesar, Kurukshetra, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 186/332/353/506 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no.2.

Pursuant to the order of this court dated July 02, 2021, a report has been received from the learned CJM, Kurukshetra, dated 18.08.2021, stating therein that the petitioners as also the complainant in the FIR, i.e. respondent no.2, Rishi Kapoor, appeared before that court, with all of them stating that the

matter has been compromised between them and with the assessment of that court being that the compromise is without any undue influence or pressure.

Though in the reply filed by the DSP, Headquarters, Kurukshetra, (which is ordered to be taken on record), it has been stated that the petition should be dismissed in view of the offences committed by the petitioners and with it also to be noticed that one of the offences alleged to have been committed is one punishable under Section 186 of the IPC (as regards obstructing a public servant in the discharge of his public functions, the complainant being a conductor on a bus in the Haryana Roadways), yet looking at the nature of offences involved and the fact that the matter has been amicably compromised between the parties, the petition is allowed and FIR No.57, dated 11.02.2021, registered at Police Station Thanesar, Kurukshetra, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 186/332/353/506 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
