Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that father of the petitioner, who was working as a Lineman in the respondent-Corporation, had fallen down while repairing the electronic transformer on 02.04.2016. The father of the petitioner had superannuated on 31.05.2016 and succumbed to the injuries on 26.07.2016, which he had received in the aforementioned incident. The petitioner had applied for the compassionate appointment and his case had been recommended by the Assistant Executive Engineer on 08.09.2016 (Annexure P-9). The petitioner has also filed several representations but no action has been taken thereon. He, therefore, prays that he would be satisfied if this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexures P-15) in accordance with law.

Issue notice to respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Mr. Aditya Chadha, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 to 5.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexures P-15) in accordance with law within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
