Vide this common order, bunch of above-mentioned petitions are being disposed of, since not only the facts but the issues raised therein are also similar. For brevity, recitals are being taken from CWP-9954-2022.

2. Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing impugned letter dated 19.04.2022 (Annexure P-6) issued by respondent No.4 to petitioner thereby restraining him from using the gradation certificate dated 17.03.2022 (Annexure P-5) for any employment.

3. On an earlier hearing held on 11.10.2022, following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned State counsel submits that per his information the earlier gradation certificates given on the basis of participation in the yachting championship conducted by the Haryana Sailing (Yatching) Association were inadvertently issued and steps are being taken to cancel the same. However, he seeks time to re-confirm the same and file an appropriate affidavit.

Post it on 02.11.2022.

Photocopy of this order be placed on file of the connected case.”

4. An affidavit dated 27.10.2022 has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1, 3 & 4, wherein it has been stated that the Department of Sports & Youth Affairs, Haryana has cancelled all 20 Sports Gradation Certificates of Grade D issued to the sportspersons, including petitioner(s) which were issued on the basis of participation in events conducted by the Haryana Sailing (Yachting) Association.

5. In view of the aforesaid, no further grounds are made out. Dismissed. It is expected of the respondents to take action, as per aforesaid affidavit.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
