[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 26.02.2021 in CWP No.4598 of 2021

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.4598 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide the representations submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned AAG refers to orders, Annexures R2/2 and R2/3 dated 16.05.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioners for stepping up of their pay.

[4] It needs mentioning here that on 20.05.2022 reply had been filed by the learned State counsel and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners who had requested for an adjournment to go over the same and to address arguments, whereupon the matter was

adjourned to today.

[5] Today, none is present on behalf of the petitioners. In the circumstances, it appears that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition.

[6] In view of the position noted above, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge orders, Annexures R2/2 and R2/3 dated 16.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
