Present petition is under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 15 dated 25.02.2021, registered under Sections 306/34 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Lambran, District Jalandhar Rural.

On 20.05.2021, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 13.05.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CRM-M-18827-2021.

Notice of motion.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigation Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-18827-2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation, the investigation of the case is complete and challan has been presented in the Court.

On instructions from HC Shingara Singh, learned State counsel has not assailed the aforesaid factual aspects and states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 20.05.2021, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
