Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0344 dated 13.09.2020 under Section 379-B, 392, 397, 412 and 120-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station IMT Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Status report by way of affidavit of Ms. Medha Bhushan, IPC, Asstt. Superintendent of Police, Sampla, District Rohtak has been filed today in Court. Copy thereof has been furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the above mentioned status report, another case bearing FIR No.710 dated 07.12.2020 under Section 392 read with Section 34 of the IPC has been registered against the petitioner at Police Station Bawana, Delhi and the petitioner was arrested therein on 30.12.2020 and he is facing trial and the case is now fixed for 21.07.2022 in Court at Rohini, Delhi.

The aforesaid fact has not been disclosed in the present petition and to the contrary it has been specifically mentioned in paragraph no.12 of the petition that there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition to file afresh with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforementioned.
