[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that payment of the principal amount having been made in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 17.03.2021 in CWP No.6143 of 2021, the only relief remaining is payment of interest @ 8% per annum on the delayed payment for which the petitioner does not press the instant petition, but seeks liberty for the petitioner to take out execution proceedings in accordance with law for realization of interest in terms of the aforementioned order.

[2] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
