Through this petition, petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 298 dated 26.11.2020 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 365, 506 IPC (Section 367 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Bass, District Hisar.

The FIR was lodged on the complaint of one Kamal who stated that he is running a motor cycle repair shop at bus stand of village Garhi. On 26.04.2020 at about 10.00 AM he went to petrol pump situated at Garhi-Hansi Road to fetch diesel for his motorcycle. One Sandeep of his village was working as salesman at the said petrol pump. The complainant requested him to fill diesel in his motorcycle. Upon this, he told him to go to another machine. But when he insisted to get diesel from his machine, Sandeep pushed him and he fell down from the motorcycle. Thereafter, another salesman filled diesel in his cane and he left the petrol pump and went to his shop at Village Garhi. At about 12.30 p.m. one Lokesh came to his shop for repair of his motorcycle. In the meantime, Sandeep alongwith four unknown boys came to his shop in a

Tata vehicle and started beating him. They forcibly put him in the said Tata vehicle and took him to the petrol pump. Jagbir and Bhajan accompanied the accused on a separate motorcycle. They gave him kicks and punches at the petrol pump. The complainant sustained injuries on his lower legs, right ribs, teeth, nose and both eyes. He raised alarm and was saved by the passers-by.

Per contra, learned State counsel submits that as per the MLRs of the complainant, he has suffered fracture of his ribs. He further submits that the petitioner was seen in the CCTV footage installed in the premises of petrol pump. He was actively involved in the commission of offence.

Keeping in view of the nature of the allegations, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
