ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 10 dated 04.03.2021, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station NRI, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations pertaining to the year 2004 and the dispute is primarily civil in nature. He also contends that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the complainant contends that in view of serious allegations against the petitioner, he is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

This Court, by the order dated 18.11.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, contends that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 18.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
