This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Certiorari for quashing of the impugned order 30.03.2022 (Annexures P-10 and P-12), whereby the petitioner was dismissed from service by respondent No.2, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ravi Kamal Gupta, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 & 3 and has pointed out that although two different orders of dismissal were passed against the petitioner for two different kinds of charges, however, the petitioner has challenged the order relating to only one charge, but twice; as if he is challenging two different orders. Still further, it is pointed out that the petitioner is having remedy of statutory appeal, the same is mentioned in the impugned order, as well.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to avail the remedy of statutory appeal, but in accordance with law.
