The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case DDR No.36 dated 04.06.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC added later on registered in FIR No.107 dated 04.06.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 05.05.2022 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Manmohan Singh Aulakh, PPS, DSP, Sub-Division Majitha, Amritsar in court which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 05.05.2022

and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 05.05.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
