The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No. 85 dated 17.10.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 427 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

In pursuance of the order dated 09.04.2019, the PM/JJB/Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patiala has sent his report dated 15.05.2019 as per which the complainant- Jobandeep Singh has not turned up before the Board for recording his statement with respect to the compromise and has thus stated that the matter has not been compromised.

In view of the same, present petition is dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise in case the compromise is effected between the parties.
