Mr. Rishabh Singla, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has stated that the petitioner was only a Manager of the Rubi Credit Co-operative Society and it is a case where no money has been transferred in his personal capacity and apart from the above in fact rather he himself was shunted out of the service by the Society. He further stated that be that as it may, the petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated 09.05.2022 and in pursuance thereof, he has joined the investigation and has cooperated with the investigation process and therefore has submitted that the order dated 09.05.2022 may be confirmed.

Mr. Amit Rana, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has stated, on instructions from ASI Kulvir Singh, that it is correct that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he has fully cooperated with the investigation process and is not required for custodial interrogation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

As per the learned counsel for the petitioner, he was only a Manager of the Society and no money has been transferred in his personal capacity. The learned State counsel has specifically stated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the aforesaid position, this Court deems it fit and proper to allow this petition. Consequently, the order dated 09.05.2022 is hereby confirmed.

The petition stands allowed.
