1. The petitioner's application under Order 1 Rule 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 has been dismissed by the Court. The petitioner wants that he should be impleaded as defendant No.5 in a suit, filed by Sh. Baldev Singh against his siblings. The plaintiff claims that he is the owner in possession of the residential house. The applicant claims that he, vide a sale deed/agreement, purchased the property from Sh. Balwant Singh (defendant No.1).
2. The trial Court, after discussing the matter, has dismissed the application.
3. After having heard the learned counsel for the parties, at length, this Court is of view that the petitioner can file his suit claiming right, title or interest on the basis of the alleged sale deed/agreement.
4. With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.
