The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to decide the representation filed before the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana, regarding cancellation of red card and/or to revoke the cancellation orders passed by respondent No.3.

Written statement on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed wherein the respondents have averred that a Three Member Committee verified the grievances of the petitioner after affording an

opportunity of hearing and decided the appeal in favour of the petitioner vide order dated 09.09.2022 and the red card issued to Sh. Jagdev Singh son of Sh. Tehal Singh (father of the petitioner) has also been restored.

The relevant extract of the written reply reads thus:-

“Thereafter the petitioner had also moved application directly to the Revenue, Rehabilitation and Disaster Management Department being dis-satisfied with the orders of Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana, which was forwarded to Commissioner, Patiala Division, Patiala for necessary action. The Three Member Committee after giving due opportunity of hearing and verifying the documents of the petitioner decided the appeal vide orders dated 09-09-2022 (Annexure R-4) whereby Red Card issued to Sh. Jagdev Singh S/o Sh. Tehal Singh (father of the petitioner) has been restored.”

Since the petitioner wanted revocation of the cancellation of the red card and the needful has already been done by the respondent authorities vide order dated 09.09.2022, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
