By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of 'mandamus' directing the respondents to issue a Letter of Intent (LOI) and to allot and deliver the possession of an industrial plot measuring 500 sq.yards in IT City, SAS Nagar, to her, upon her being declared successful in the draw of lots held on 30.11.2016 under reserved category 'K'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the order Annexure P-4, dated 23.12.2020, passed by the appellate authority, wherein it was eventually directed as follows:-

“In the light of the aforementioned circumstances, it is ordered that the case of the appellant be considered and decided under the category in which she applied and she be given an opportunity of personal hearing, while keeping in mind the letter issued by PUDA dated 07.01.2019.”

He submits that despite almost 1 ½ years having gone by since that date, no action has been taken for implementation of that order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Estate Officer, GMADA, to pass necessary orders in terms of the aforesaid order.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Estate Officer, GMADA, to pass a speaking order duly obviously taking into consideration the directions issued by the appellate authority.

Of course, if the order of the appellate authority has been reversed or stayed by the competent authority, the Estate Officer will state so in the speaking order to be passed by him/her.

The necessary speaking order would be passed by the Estate Officer within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
