SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

On 07.05.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.36 dated 26.03.2022, registered under Section 498-A of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran, Annexure P-1.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR, Annexure P-1, has been registered by the daughter-in-law of the petitioner and the allegations levelled against the petitioner are false. He submits that the injuries allegedly inflicted on the complainant are not attributed to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab,

accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State. By referring to the Medical Report, State counsel submits that the complainant has suffered abrasions on her limbs and has complained of pain in the neck and head. As per his instructions, the injuries are attributed to the son of the petitioner.

List on 13.09.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would appear as and when called for by the Investigating Officer and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Upon instructions from ASI Gurpreet, State counsel submits that petitioner has joined investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed and order dated 07.05.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
