This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No. 5 dated 12.4.2022, under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Range, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 20.6.2022, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Vijay Pal Singh, Vigilance Bureau submits that the petitioner has joined investigation, however, his voice sample is required.
