Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0030 dated 11.04.2022, under Sections 323, 34, 376 (2) (N), 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Women Hisar, District Hisar.

By virtue of the order dated 06.05.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation and to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the parties have settled their disputes amicably before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in compliance of the settlement the petitioner is paying Rs.3,50,000/- to the complainant today vide DD No.744342 dated 02.08.2022.

The same has been accepted by learned counsel for the complainant who has also affirmed the factum of the settlement.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the status report by way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hqrs., Hisar and affirmed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 06.05.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
