The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents to account for and pay all the relevant dues as the petitioner being the vocational training provider had imparted training of certain courses to the candidates and a further prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari seeking quashing of office order dated 14.01.2015 (Annexure P-11) passed by the respondents.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the agreement between the parties contemplates an arbitration clause and the parties have already sought to invoke its remedy under arbitration. He thus does not press the instant petition at this stage so as to pursue the alternative remedy.

Disposed of accordingly.
