The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to appoint him on compassionate ground.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the father of the petitioner, who was working as an Assistant Lineman, had expired on 09.09.2000. The petitioner is eligible to be considered for compassionate appointment under the policy of the respondents. The petitioner had been repeatedly requesting the respondents to offer him an appointment, but they did not take any action thereon.

Heard.

The father of the petitioner is stated to have expired in the year 2000. This petition has been preferred now after 22 years of the death of the employee. It is well settled that appointment on compassionate ground is to be made to help the family of the deceased employee to tide over immediate

financial crisis. This petition has been filed after 22 years of the death of the employee.

Consequently, I do not find any merit in this petition which stands dismissed.
