The petitioner is seeking to quash the FIR No.0155 dated 08.07.2018 under Section 376 IPC and Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jatinder Singh, has asserted that the petitioner has been acquitted by the learned trial Court and the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categoric assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. He shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
