The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.29 dated 10.03.2019 registered under Sections 363 and 366 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner on the basis of a compromise dated 24.03.2019 (Annexure P-2) entered into between the parties.

On 10.04.2019 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise, who in turn was directed to submit a report along with the recorded statements with regard to the number of persons arrayed as accused; whether any of them is proclaimed offender and whether the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

As directed, report dated 16.05.2019 from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Fatehgarh Sahib has been received as per which the parties had recorded their statements before the Trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them; only the petitioner is arrayed as the accused; he has

not been declared a proclaimed offender and that the compromise is voluntary and is not the result of any pressure or coercion in any manner.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR in which offences are not heinous as also the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in Narinder Singh vs. State of Punjab (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash FIR No.29 dated 10.03.2019 registered under Sections 363 and 366 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.
