Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short “the Code) for quashing of FIR No.178 dated 18.12.2021 under Sections 376, 511 of IPC, 1860, and Section 67-A of Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot, Annexure P-1, alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 18.04.2022, Annexure P-2.

Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the State.

Upon instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, State counsel submits that the prosecutrix has supported the allegations in her statement recorded under Section 164 of the Code. Still further, he submits that the lewd video of the prosecution has been circulated by the petitioner among a number of persons.

Faced with the above as well as judgment of the Supreme Court in ***State of Madhya Pradesh versus Laxmi Narayan and others (2019) 5 SCC 688***, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
