Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing letter/order dated 16.07.2019 (Annexure P-2), whereby respondents have restricted the holidays of members of petitioner-Union from 36 holidays to 8 holidays in a calendar year, who are working as technical staff.

2. On the first hearing i.e. 23.05.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to place on record the relevant material to show that members of the petitioner-Union, as a matter of right, are entitled to 36 holidays in a calendar year which have now been reduced to 8 holidays. Post it on 31.05.2022.”

3. Thereafter, on the next date i.e. 31.05.2022, the learned counsel for the petitioner again sought time to place the relevant material on record in

terms of afore-mentioned order dated 23.05.2022. On the subsequent date i.e. 13.07.2022, none caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was adjourned on 03.08.2022. Thereafter, on the last date i.e. 03.08.2022, the learned counsel for the petitioner again sought an adjournment. Even today, none appears on behalf of the petitioner.

4. Despite ample opportunities, petitioner has not complied with order dated 23.05.2022. Consequently, the petition is dismissed for non-compliance thereof.

5. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
