Prayer in this petition is for quashing of DDR No. 26 dated 17.04.2021, registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Ludhiana under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34, 148, 149 of the IPC in FIR No. 82 dated 15.04.2021, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 of the IPC, registered at the said police station, along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Reply, filed by way of the affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Ludhiana, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of the aforesaid affidavit, submits that after conducting the investigation, it is found that petitioner Yogesh Bakshi has no role in the incident and the inquiry report is approved by the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and the same will be submitted in Court within a period of eight weeks from today.
