Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents and to direct respondent No.3 not to call the petitioner to the Police Station without following due process of law.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was married to respondent No.4 about twenty five years earlier, the relationship between them is strained and she is staying separately for the last 14-15 years. Counsel submits that out of the said marriage, two children were born, one child is with the petitioner and other child-respondent No.5 is living with respondent No.4. He submits that the petitioner has recently purchased some property and her husband-respondent No.4 is harassing her as he wants the property to be transferred in his name. He submits that the

petitioner has submitted representations, Annexures P-1 and P-2, to the official respondents, but they are not being attended to. Still further, it is his submission that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the same.

Notice of motion, restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on their behalf.

Considering the prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur-respondent No.2 to examine the representation, Annexure P-2, and take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.
