1. This petition was filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protecting life and liberty of petitioner from the hands of respondent No.5.

2. There are civil litigation pending in which there is interim protection.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagsir Singh submits that proceedings under Section 107 and 151 of Cr.P.C. were initiated against the petitioner and private respondent. Thereafter proceedings under Section 145 of Cr.P.C. were initiated against the petitioner. The petitioner has challenged the Kalendra before this Court.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of.

6. Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of grievance if any.
