1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 04.03.2020 in CWP-6094-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 04.03.2020, reveals that CWP-6094-2020, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide appeal dated 01.12.2018 filed by the petitioners within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Mr. Sandeep Mann, Addl.A.G. Haryana, has referred to order Annexure R-1 dated 23.05.2022 attached alongwith reply dated 25.05.2022 and states that order Annexure P-1 dated 04.03.2020 has been complied with as the appeal filed by the petitioners has been decided.

4. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in the circumstances the petitioners may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to challenge order

Annexure R-1 dated 23.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in

accordance with law. The same is not opposed to by the learned Addl. A.G. Haryana.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order Annexure R-1 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
