The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.31 dated 22.2.2021 registered under Sections 323, 354, 354-A, 377, 498-A, 406, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station, Women Cell, Panipat.

By virtue of the order dated 15.2.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 15.2.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Counsel submits that parties have amicably settled their dispute and both petitioner and complainant are residing together as husband and wife.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that recovery of dowry articles remains to be effected.

In view of the above, the order dated 15.2.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
