Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.74 dated 07.04.2022, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana (Punjab).

Vide order dated 06.05.2022, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 06.05.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He further submits that as per the order passed by this Court, the parties appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. However, the same remained unsuccessful.

Report of the Mediator has also been received affirming the fact that despite best efforts, the parties could not arrive at any amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that recovery of some gold articles remains to be effected.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. However, recovery of some gold articles remains to be effected.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the Court is of the opinion that the matter needs to be investigated and thereafter tried by the trial Court in accordance with the law. Accordingly, interim order dated 06.05.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C

Petition stands allowed.
